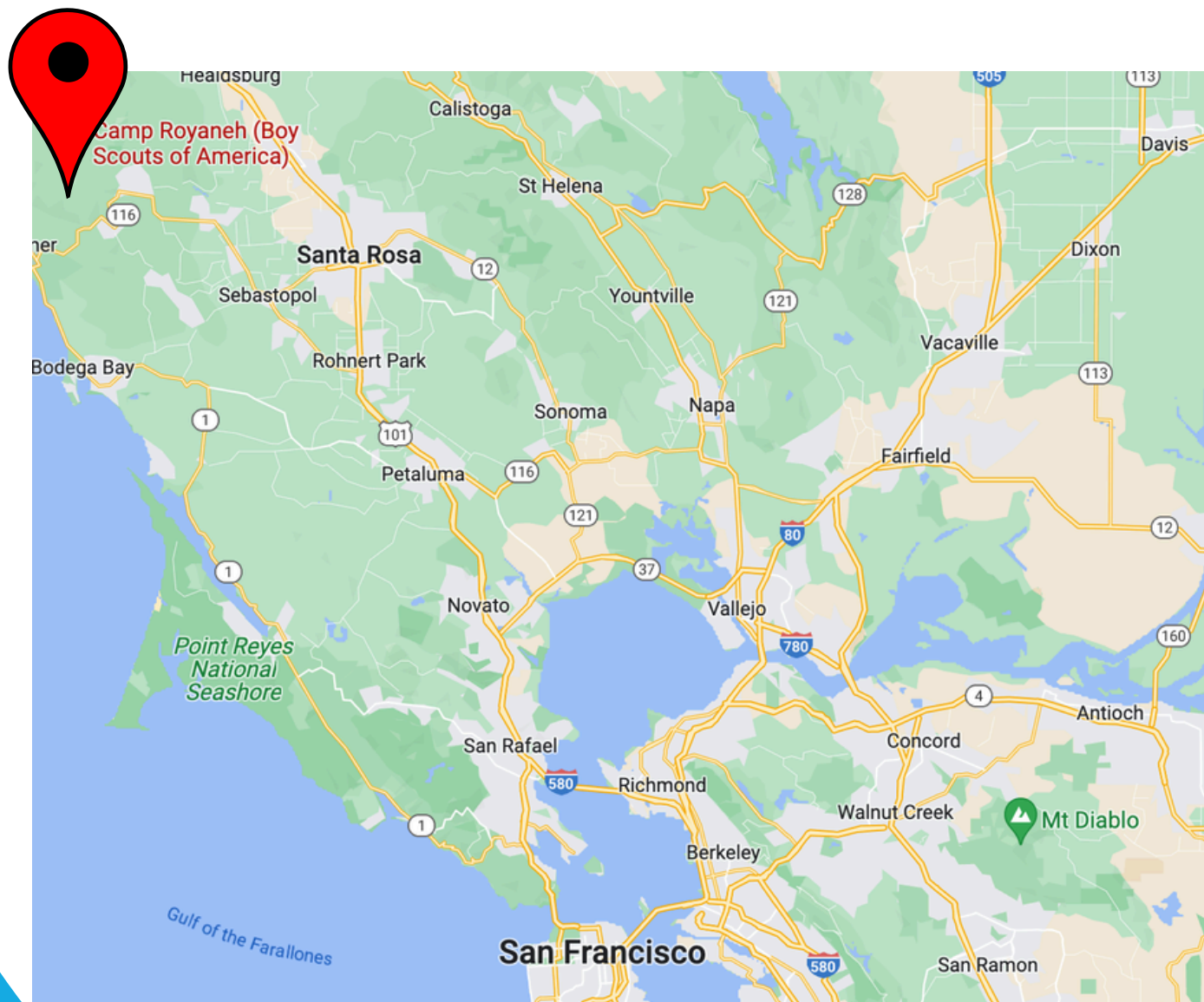

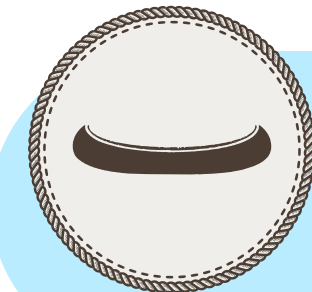

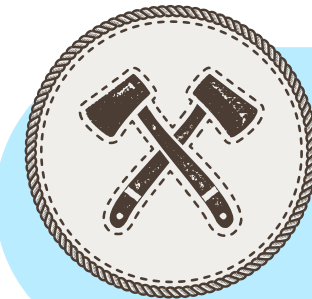

Arrival to Camp



- **Arrive between 12pm and 2pm**
 - No Earlier!
 - If you arrive past 2pm, your scouts may miss out the camp tour
- **Greeted first by speed bumps and secondly by our staff**
 - Send 1 Car of gear to campsite at a time
 - Other cars park at rangers house and hike up the hill
- **Troop Guide should be sent to campsite after ~20 minutes of your first car checking in**
 - Campsite Inspection
 - Begin Tour! (Next Slide)

Camp Tour

Guided by your Troop Guide

- TG Will guide you around camp, telling you all there is to know about the facilities, program areas, and everything else
- First stop is Admin to meet with Medic and Admin Team
 - Need Med Forms, Firearms Slips, and AB506 Paperwork
- While your guide will explain all you need to know about camp, you'll meet a few key directors along the way
 - Chaos at the Barn to talk about Horsemanship & Trailride
 - Christian in Shooting Sports to learn about range safety
 - Mya in the Dining Hall to learn about Dining Hall operations and discuss dietary restrictions
 - Aquatics Team for those who will be swimming to take swim checks
 - We do not accept swim checks from other camps
 - Only those who plan to swim (Rank Requirements, Merit Badges, etc. need to take a swim check
- Adult Leader Meeting at 4pm, Send at Least 1 Adult

Merit Badge Process

- Our rosters will be pre-programmed from your selection via BlackPug
- The Monday adult leader meeting will include a tutorial on accessing these records digitally
- Tuesday and Friday, BlackPug will be updated with class progress and attendance
- Saturday, after flags but before 10:00am, Scouts may visit program areas to complete partials
- BlackPug will allow you to export requirements to Excel, Scoutbook, Troopmaster, etc.

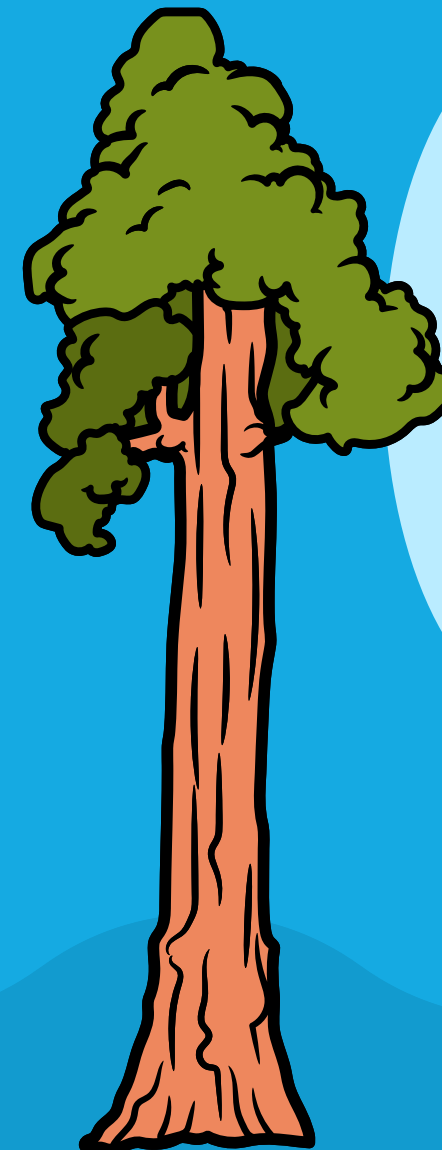
